Dear Parent / Guardian,

This letter is to inform you that there are students enrolled at Bradford Elementary School with severe latex allergies. Strict avoidance of all latex products is the only way to prevent a life threatening allergic reaction for these students. We are asking for your assistance in providing a safe learning environment for students with life threatening allergies.

Due to the severity of the student's latex allergy, Bradford Elementary School must be latex free. If exposed to latex, the students may develop a life threatening allergic reaction that requires emergency medical treatment. Please do not send any items containing latex to school with you child. Latex is contained in products such as bandaids, rubber gloves, rubber bands, balloons and some playground balls. We are requesting that refrain from sending your child to school with any of the products described. Please read labels of any product you will be sending into school to make certain that it is latex free. Please consult with you student's teacher before sending any items to school for special occasions or projects. Balloons will not be allowed at any time at Bradford Elementary School.
